



## GRAMMAR: OBJECT PRONOUNS

### 1) What are object pronouns?

✓ The function of object pronouns is to replace nouns.

- She's my friend. I really enjoy being with **her**. (with my friend)
- I like this film. I saw **it** last week. (I saw the film)

✓ An object pronoun comes after a verb or a preposition.

- He begged **her** to live with **him**.  
(**Her** is the object of the verb *begged* and **him** is the object of the preposition *with*)
- She told **them** the truth.  
(**Them** is the object of the verb *told*)
- I like **you** but you don't like **me**.
- Do you really hate **her**?
- She loves sitting next to **him**.
- She always writes e-mails to **us**.

### 2) Which are object pronouns?

✓ Object pronouns in English are:

Subject pronouns	Object pronouns (they replace nouns)
I ->	<b>Me</b>
You ->	<b>You</b>
He ->	<b>Him</b>
She ->	<b>Her</b>
It ->	<b>It</b>
We ->	<b>Us</b>
You ->	<b>You</b>
They ->	<b>Them</b>
