THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS

- 1. Put the verbs into the present continuous tense in its affirmative, negative or interrogative form.
 - Listen to the birds. They (sing) are singing.
 - Look at that one. It (fly) is flying high in the sky.
 - The other one (play) is playing with a worm.
 - I feel happy because I (have) **am having** a good time here.
 - Look! Mary (jump) is jumping into the water.
 - You can't find Jerry at home right now. He (study) **is studying** in the library.
 - Eddie (not, write) **isn't writing** a novel. He (write) **is writing** a poem.
 - Uncle Terry and his friend (fish) are fishing at the lake today.
 They (not, fish) aren't fishing at the beach.
 - What (you/ do) are you doing right now?. I (write) writing a letter.
 - (she/ drink) Is she drinking a glass of orange juice? No, she (not/ drink) isn't drinking a glass of orange juice. She (have) is having a cup of tea.
- 2. Put the verbs into the correct tense in this dialogue: present simple or present continuous.

Ann: Look! Sara (go) is going to the movies.

Aaron: On her right hand, Sara (carry) **is carrying** her handbag.

Ann: The handbag (be) is very beautiful.

Aaron: Sara usually (put) **puts** on black shoes but now she (wear) **is wearing** white trainers.

Ann: And look, she (take) is taking an umbrella.
