**We are going to have our house painted next week.**

2. I think the mechanic will repair my car tomorrow.

**I think I will have my car repaired tomorrow by the mechanic.**

3. My wheels were fixed by the mechanic.

**I had my wheels fixed by the mechanic.**

4. The cleaning lady has polished the floor for me.

**I have had the floor polished by the cleaning lady.**

5. Someone is installing a telephone line in our house today.

**We are having a telephone line installed in our house today.**

6. The optician has to check my sight.

**I have to have my sight checked by the optician.**

7. The workers fixed the window for my mum some weeks ago.

**My mum had the window fixed some weeks ago by the workers.**

8. The supermarket boys are delivering the shopping for me this afternoon.

**I am having the shopping delivered this afternoon by the supermarket boys.**

9. I should check my brakes before the winter.

**I should have my brakes checked before the winter.**

10. Someone has redone Alice's office.

**Alice has had her office redone.**

11. The milkman has just delivered the milk to Mary.

**Mary has just had the milk delivered by the milkman.**

12. The hairdresser is cutting my hair next week.

**I am having my hair cut next week by the hairdresser.**

13. The lawyer is preparing our contracts for next week.

**We are having our contracts prepared for next week by the lawyer.**

14. The local newspaper will print Anita's article soon.

**Anita will have her article printed soon by the local newspaper.**

15. Someone made Betty's wedding dress three months ago.

**Betty had her wedding dress made three months ago.**
