- b) The kids are calm today. They must be tired. Certainty/ Present
- c) Although Leila was very hungry, she didn't eat very much. She might not have liked the food. Possibility/ Past
- d) The phone is ringing. It must be Mary. She promised she would call. Certainty/
 Present
- e) John had a terrible accident. He **should have stopped** when the traffic lights were red. **Advice/ Past**
- f) I don't know why she got so many bad grades. She might have been lazy studying.
 Possibility/ Past
- g) I didn't know you needed help. You should have told me. Advice/ Past
- h) I am so tired. I need some rest. I think I should take a week off. Advice/ Present
- i) He could run so fast when he was young. Ability/ Past
- j) Nancy can't have gone on holiday. I have just met her in the street. Certainty/ Past
