



## **GRAMMAR**

### **HAVE GOT**

El verbo **have got** significa **tener**:

#### **1. PRESENTE SIMPLE**

##### **Affirmative**

I have (I've) got...

You have (you've) got...

He/She/It **has** (he/she/it's) got...

We have (we've) got...

You have (you've) got...

They have (they've) got...

##### **Negative**

I have not (I haven't) got...

You have not (you haven't) got...

He/She/It **has** not (he/she/it hasn't) got...

We have not (we haven't) got...

You have not (you haven't) got...

They have not (they haven't) got...

##### **Interrogative**

Have I got..?

Have you got..?

**Has** he/she/it got..?

Have we got..?

Have you got..?

Have they got..?

Oberva que la tercera persona singular se forma de manera irregular: cambia de **have** a **has**.

##### **Examples**

+ = I have got a new car/ I've got a new car.

- = I have not got a new car/ I haven't got a new car.

? = Have you got a new car? -> Yes, I have (Yes, I've) o No, I haven't/ I've not/ I have not; (~~I haven't got or I have not got~~)

## 2. PASADO SIMPLE

### Affirmative

I had (I'd) got...

You had (you'd) got...

He/she/it had  
(he/she/it'd) got...

We had (we'd) got...

You had (you'd) got...

They had (they'd) got...

### Negative

I had not (I hadn't)  
got...

You had not (you  
hadn't) got...

He/she/it had not (he  
hadn't) got...

We had not (we hadn't)  
got...

You had not (you  
hadn't) got...

They had not (they  
hadn't) got...

### Interrogative

Had I got..?

Had you got..?

Had he/she/it got..?

Had we got..?

Had you got..?

Had they got..?

Observa que todas las personas son iguales: la forma **had** no varía en ninguna persona.

### Examples

+ = I had got a new car/ I'd got a new car.

- = I had not got a new car/ I hadn't got a new car.

? = Had you got a new car? -> Yes, I had (~~Yes, I'd~~) o No, I hadn't/ I'd not/  
I had not; (~~I hadn't got or I had not got~~)
