# HAVE GOT

El verbo *have got* significa *tener:* 

# **1. PRESENTE SIMPLE**

<u>Affirmative</u>	<u>Negative</u>	<b>Interrogative</b>
I have (I've) got	I have not (I haven't) got	Have I got?
You have (you've) got	You have not (you haven't) got	Have you got?
He/She/It <b>has</b> (he/she/it's) got	He/She/It <b>has</b> not (he/she/it hasn't) got	Has he/she/it got?
We have (we've) got	We have not (we haven't) got	Have we got?
You have (you've) got	You have not (you haven't) got	Have you got?
They have (they've) got	They have not (they haven't) got	Have they got?

Oberva que la tercera persona singular se forma de manera irregular: cambia de *have* a *has*.

# **Examples**

- + = I have got a new car/ I've got a new car.
- = I have not got a new car/ I haven't got a new car.

**?** = Have you got a new car? -> Yes, I have (<del>Yes, I've</del>) *o* No, I haven't/ I've not/ I have not; (<del>I haven't got or I have not got</del>)



#### 2. PASADO SIMPLE

<u>Affirmative</u>	<u>Negative</u>	<b>Interrogative</b>
I had (I'd) got	I had not (I hadn't) got	Had I got?
You had (you'd) got	You had not (you hadn't) got	Had you got?
He/she/it had (he/she/it'd) got	He/she/it had not (he hadn't) got	Had he/she/it got?
We had (we'd) got	We had not (we hadn't) got	Had we got?
You had (you'd) got	You had not (you hadn't) got	Had you got?
They had (they'd) got	They had not (they hadn't) got	Had they got?

Oberva que todas las personas son iguales: la forma **had** no varía en ninguna persona.

# **Examples**

- + = I had got a new car/ I'd got a new car.
- = I had not got a new car/ I hadn't got a new car.

**?** = Had you got a new car? -> Yes, I had (<del>Yes, I'd</del>) *o* No, I hadn't/ I'd not/ I had not; (<del>I hadn't got or I had not got</del>)

# 3. USOS DE TO HAVE

- Indica posesión

She has a big house in Ireland: tiene una casa grande en Irlanda.
