- RELEGATION

- d. Physical challenge against an opponent, usually using the shoulder and upper arm, which is kept to the body

- STRIKER

- a. A player who plays mainly in the middle part of the pitch
- b. A player whose main role is to prevent the opposition from scoring
- c. A player whose main goal is to score a goal
- d. A player used to replay another player

- OTHER MATCHES

- a. Any match played by national "A" teams in an official competition organized under the auspices of FIFA, confederations or national football associations
- b. Any match played in unofficial competitions
- c. Any match played by no national "A" teams in official or unofficial competitions
- d. Any match played by national "A" teams in an unofficial competition

- OUTSIDE AGENT

- a. Anyone named on the team list with the exception of players and substitutes
- b. Anyone not named on the team list as a player, substitute or team official
- c. Anyone named on the team list, including players and substitutes
- d. Anyone who enters the field of play without the referee's permission, with the exception of players and referees

- GOAL KICK

- a. A method of restarting the play that is awarded when the whole ball passed over the goal line, having last touched a player of the attacking team, and a goal is not scored
- b. A method of restarting the play that is awarded when the whole ball passed over the goal line, having last touched a player of the defending team, and a goal is not scored

- c. A method of restarting the play that is awarded when the whole ball passed over the touch line, on the ground or in the air
- d. A method of restarting the play that is awarded if a player commits a direct free kick offence inside their penalty area or off the field as part of the play, as outlined in Laws 12 and 13
