✓ Circle the correct definition for the following words or sentences:

- TO SEND-OFF

- a. To tell a player officially to leave the pitch because he has done something that is not allowed by the laws of the game.
- b. To warn a player if he is guilty of unsporting behaviour; shows dissent by word or action; persistently infringes the laws of the game; delays the restart of play; fails to respect the required distance when the play is restarted with a corner kick or free kick; enters or re-enters the field of play without the referee's permission or deliberately leaves the field of play without the referee's permission.
- c. To deliberately fall over when tackled in order to deceive the referee into awarding a free kick.

- FOUL

- a. Action of kicking or heading the ball to another player on one's own team.
- b. An illegal action punishable by a free kick.
- c. The striking of the ball in the air by the player's head.

- INDIRECT FREE KICK

- a. A punishment given by the referee for a violation of the rules by the defending team inside their own penalty area. It is most commonly given for fouls and handballs.
- b. A kick awarded to a player after being fouled by the opposition. The player kicks a stationary ball, with opposing players forced to stand 9.15 metres away from him. A goal may be scored directly against the opposing side without the ball having first touched another player.
- c. A free kick from which a goal cannot be directly scored. It can be awarded when a player commits a foul other than a penalty foul. It can be awarded for a player touching the ball for a second time after a restart, or a goalkeeper touching the ball with his hands when a team mate has deliberately passed it back to him. It is also awarded when a player from the opposing team is yellow or red carded for no specific foul or most commonly, when an opposing player has been caught offside.
