## VOCABULARY

- ✓ **ADVANTAGE:** After a foul, a referee can apply *advantage* if the team that was fouled will benefit more from letting the play continue than from the referee stopping the play and awarding a free kick. -> *Ventaja*
- ✓ **DEFENSIVE WALL:** When a player has been awarded a direct free kick, the defending team can try to stop the attacker from scoring by forming a *defensive wall* in front of the goal. -> *Barrera defensiva*
- ✓ **EQUALISER:** When a team is losing by one goal, if the team scores a goal that makes the scores equal, that goal is called *equalizer*. -> *Gol de empate*
- ✓ **HEADER:** When a player controls the ball with his head, it is called a *header*. Many goals are scored through *headers* from corner kicks. -> *Dar al balón con la cabeza (cabezazo)*
- ✓ **IN PLAY:** When the ball is *in play*, any player can try to take the ball and score a goal. -> *En juego*
- ✓ **OPEN GOAL:** When there is no defender or goalkeeper between an attacking player and the goal, the goal is called *open goal*. -> *portería vacía*
- ✓ **OUT OF PLAY:** If a ball crosses the goal line or touch line, it is *out of play*. The ball is put back in play with a throw-in, corner kick or goal kick. -> *Fuera de juego (balón)* \***No confundir con offside**
- ✓ **OWN GOAL:** If a player scores against his team, that player has scored an *own goal*. -> *Gol en propia meta*
- ✓ **POSSESSION:** The time when a player or team have the ball is called *possession*. When a player is tackled, they lose *possession*. -> *Posesión*
- ✓ **PENALTY SHOOTOUT:** At the end of a match, in a knockout round of a competition, if there is no winner, the match is decided with a *penalty shootout*. The teams take turns to take penalties to find a winner. -> *Tanda de penaltis*

As you already know, it is quite important for a referee to know as much vocabulary as possible, that is why you have here more terms related to The Game.
