TYPES OF SHOT





VOCABULARY

- ✓ **KICK-OFF:** the first kick of the game when two players from the same team, in the centre circle, play the ball and start the match. -> *Saque de inicio*
- ✓ **GOAL KICK:** the kick taken by the goalkeeper when the ball is put behind the goal line by the opposing team. -> Saque de meta
- ✓ **FREE KICK:** the kick awarded to a team by the referee after a foul has been committed against it. -> *Tiro libre*
- ✓ **PENALTY:** a free shot at goal awarded by the referee to a team after a foul has been committed in the penalty area. -> *Penalti*
- ✓ CORNER KICK: a kick from the corner flag awarded to the attacking team when the ball has crossed the goal line after last being touched by a player of the defending team. -> Saque de esquina
- ✓ **THROW-IN:** a throw-in is taken from the touch line after the ball has gone out of play. It is the only time a player can handle the ball without committing a foul. -> Saque de banda
- ✓ A PASS: a kick of the ball from one player to another. -> Pase
- ✓ A CROSS: a pass from the side of the pitch into the penalty area in an attempt to find an attacker and score a goal. -> Pase cruzado
- ✓ A ONE-TWO: a passing move in which player 1 passes the ball to player 2, who immediately passes it back to player 1. -> Pase de pared
- ✓ A BACKHEEL: a kick in which the ball is hit with the heel (or the back) of the foot. -> Pase de tacón
- ✓ **A CLEARANCE** -> a defensive kick that is intended to put the ball out of danger.-> *Despeje*

As you already know, it is very important for a referee to know as much vocabulary as possible; that is why you have here more terms related to the different types of shot.
